

Launched in June 2020, this innovative ESG self-assessment tool has been tailored exclusively for the maritime industry to evaluate adherence to Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles.

The Maritime Sustainability Passport® Program provides a comprehensive framework for companies, associations, educators, and individuals in the maritime sector to assess and enhance their sustainability practices. A beacon of commitment to continuous improvement, the MSP Program embarks on a yearly renewal voyage to ensure its unwavering relevance in an ever-evolving landscape.

By covering all three critical elements of sustainability – Environmental, Social, and Governance – the NAMEPA MSP Program facilitates a holistic approach to achieving excellence in sustainable operations.



# SIX TRANSPARENCY PILLARS

At the core of the MSP Program lies the Six Transparency Pillars, each of which represents a crucial aspect of sustainability in the maritime industry:



# **Waste Management:**

Evaluating waste reduction and recycling initiatives, fostering responsible waste disposal practices, and promoting circular economy principles.



### **GHG Emissions:**

Addressing greenhouse gas emissions,

Personalized Feedback and Improvement Strategies:** By partnering with NAMEPA and ESGPlus LLC, the program provides your organization with invaluable feedback and guidance in areas where improvements can be made. Their expertise helps you develop effective strategies tailored to your unique goals and challenges, enabling you to continuously enhance your sustainability practices.
- **3. Integration of ESG Strategies:** The program serves as a platform for incorporating ESG strategies seamlessly into your day-to-day operations. It offers practical guidance on how to implement sustainable practices throughout your organization, ensuring that sustainability becomes an integral part of your business model.
- **4. Leadership in Corporate Citizenship:** By participating in the Maritime Sustainability Passport® Program, you strengthen your position as a leader in corporate citizenship, environmental stewardship, and governance. This distinction sets you apart from your competitors and showcases your proactive approach towards addressing societal and environmental concerns.
- **5. Recognition and Publicity:** The MSP Program features a robust recognition system that allows you to showcase your organization's sustainability achievements. By leveraging this platform, you can effectively communicate your sustainability efforts to a broader audience, bolstering your brand's reputation and attracting environmentally conscious partners. Moreover, this recognition builds trust among stakeholders, including customers, investors, and regulatory bodies, who value and prioritize sustainability.
- **6. Confidentiality:** To ensure confidentiality, participants in this program are protected by signing Non-Disclosure-Agreements.

# PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The MSP serves as a vital tool for companies to identify where they are on their ESG journey, and showcase their dedication to sustainability to customers, investors, and stakeholders. It assists companies in identifying areas for improvement, fostering continuous enhancement of their sustainability practices.

After your <u>online enrollment of the MSP</u>, you will receive an email from Submittable, the platform we use for the MSP Program, to set your account and start with the program. The program is divided into 2 phases:

1

The **Initial Phase** serves as an introduction of the program and applicant "Participant's Overview-Guidelines-Current Status on Sustainability and Environmental Care" with a deadline of up to 48 hours to complete and submit your registration.

2

The **Final Phase**, "Internal Policies, Procedures, Measures and Sustainability Commitment," which allows the participant to perform an in-depth self-evaluation, and is divided into Six Transparency Pillars.


During the **final phase**, the participant will upload documents containing information about the participant's current sustainability practices, certificates obtained, some policies and procedures in place and/or in process. The information given to NAMEPA should correlate with the six transparency pillars listed above. NAMEPA will keep the information provided within a secure location to ensure no private information is released. Throughout the participation in this program, the NAMEPA MSP Team will be available to assist with any questions or difficulties. The applicant has a deadline of up to 1 month to submit their response and can do so in stages.

# RECEIVING THE MSP AND MSP SEAL

Once the participant completes the program, their submission will be assessed by ESGPlus, an independent consulting firm that specializes in this work. ESGPlus has signed a non-disclosure agreement with NAMEPA to provide these services and ensure the participant's confidentiality.

After completion and positive assessment of the submission (a score of 60% or greater), the participant will receive from NAMEPA the year's Maritime Sustainability Passport® and MSP Seal as recognition of their commitment and successful participation in this program and the effort the individual/company have shown to align with ESG best practices. The participant will also receive detailed feedback on the participation and recommendations of areas for improvement.

The recognition of the Maritime Sustainability Passport® & MSP Seal will be published across industry media.




